




Get Free Support to Apply for Louisiana Water Infrastructure Funding and Financing



Louisiana's Revolving Loan Fund Programs help water systems like yours pay for needed upgrades to water infrastructure, such as replacing aging pipes, installing new treatment systems, stormwater management, and water conservation. Small and rural communities are given priority and are eligible for grants and forgivable loans.

Examples of How We May Be Able to Help You



Water system needs evaluation: initial assessments, vulnerability assessments, plan development and coordination, and asset management



Community engagement: town halls, meetings, Community Water Academies, educational materials, surveys and outreach, and partnership building



Project development: alternative analysis, engineer selection, lead service line inventories, preliminary engineering reports, environmental reviews, and source water protection and watershed planning



Technical assistance and capacity building: educational and outreach materials for decision makers, resources, water system partnerships, trainings and webinars, and tools and resources tailored to your water system's needs



Finance and funding: rates and revenue analysis, fiscal analysis, financial planning, identify funding options, and application support



Construction management: bid support, change order reviews, project inspection (limited services), and how to meet prevailing wage and "buy-American" rules

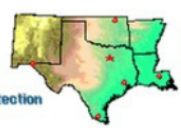
